 NOTICE OF INTENT TO INCREASE NONVOTED LEVIES
 March 12, 2018

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Victor School Board of the Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Victor School Board of Trustees estimates the following increase/decrease in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2018, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district: **The Board passed this resolution at the Regular Board Meeting held on March 12, 2018, in Room B.**
